<b>Category: Project Urgency</b>		
<i>*Per CIB policy, Project Urgency can be scored up to 30 pts total.</i>		
●	Project specifically addresses emergencies brought on by catastrophic events or severe weather conditions. <i>*Only projects that are determined to have catastrophic events can be scored the extra 10 pts.</i>	10 pts

●	<b><u>Water/Wastewater Projects</u></b> Project specifically addresses identified threats to human health and safety relative to waterborne disease outbreak, wastewater treatment and inadequate water supply, Safe Drinking Water Act compliance, including acute and chronic risk contaminants and treatment technique requirements for systems that have violation in the past year.	10-20 pts
●	<b><u>Roads/Drainage/Flood Prevention</u></b> Project specifically addresses identified threats to human health and safety to include flood and drainage (holding ponds, retention walls, levees) issues resulting from non-existent, inadequate or poorly designed infrastructure causing health and safety issues; and dam safety projects that restore to a safe condition impending failures in dam structures.	10-20 pts
●	Projects specifically and substantially addresses human health or safety benefits such as but not limited to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Description and analysis of project need;</li> <li>• Identify human health and safety concerns;</li> <li>• Identify benefit to public health;</li> <li>• Addresses minimal human health and safety provisions.</li> </ul>	4-9 pts
●	Project is for planning only.	3 pts
<b>Category: Long-Term Community Benefit</b>		<b>10</b>
●	Project clearly defines a specific long-term quality of life impact.	10 pts
●	Project has potential long-term quality of life impact based on a master plan, studies, or other documents that suggest a positive impact.	5 pts
●	No potential for long-term quality of life impact.	0 pts

<b>Category: Project Readiness</b>		<b>20</b>
<input type="radio"/>	The project is ready to proceed (completed the plan and design; other funding secured and all permits, licenses and authorizations are in place).	16-20 pts
<input type="radio"/>	The project has secured all other funding and has identified, but not secured, all permits, licenses and authorization; design is substantively complete.	10-15 pts
<input type="radio"/>	Application solely for planning costs.	5-10 pts
<input type="radio"/>	The project is adequately planned but has not secured all other funding and has not yet identified all permits, licenses and authorizations.	1-5 pts
<input type="radio"/>	Project is not realistically ready for execution or management.	0 pts
<b>Category: Regionalization</b>		<b>10</b>
<input type="radio"/>	Project serves an area >80% of the population. Project proposes to "share" infrastructure or manpower, equipment, processes, etc. Project has multiple partners who have entered into a Joint Powers Agreement for the proposed project.	10 pts
<input type="radio"/>	Project like above, but with 61-80% of the population serves the project	8 pts
<input type="radio"/>	Project serves 41-60% of population in the regional area of the project.	6 pts
<input type="radio"/>	Project serves 21-40% of population in the regional area of the project.	4 pts
<input type="radio"/>	Project effects no substantial part of the surrounding area or <20% of the population	2 pts
<input type="radio"/>	Regionalization is not considered	0 pts
<b>Category: Direct Cost Benefit</b>		<b>10*</b>
<i>*The total cost of the project (includes ALL funding sources) divided by the number of persons benefitting from the project (latest Census data) equals the direct cost benefit per person.</i>
